August 1

Jeremiah 33:3 –“Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know.”

August 2

Luke 11:2 – “Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come, Your will be done, On earth as *it is* in heaven.”

Do we earnestly pray for and see God’s will and His kingdom?

August 3

Genesis 1:1 - “In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.”

Why is it important to remember our beginnings when faced with critical decisions such as a presidential election?

August 4

Exodus 6:1 - “Then the Lord said to Moses, “Now you shall see what I will do to Pharaoh. For with a strong hand he will let them go, and with a strong hand he will drive them out of his land.”

What does this Scripture teach us about the Lord’s influence over world leaders?

August 5

Proverbs 21:1 – “The king’s heart *is* in the hand of the Lord, *Like* the rivers of water; turns it wherever He wishes.”

August 6

Leviticus 19:2b –“ You shall be holy, for I the Lord your God am holy.”

August 7

1 John 5:14 – “Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.”

Are we seeking God’s will when we pray and are we confident that He hears us?

August 8

Numbers 14:22 –“ Because all these men who have seen My glory and the signs which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness and who put me to the test now these 10 times and have not heeded my voice...”

How shall we respond to the work of God?

August 9

Deuteronomy 10:12 –“ and now, Israel, what does the Lord your God require of you but to fear the Lord your God, to walk in all his ways and to love Him, to serve the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul.”

How can we prepare ourselves to be good citizens?

August 10

Exodus 33:15 - Then he said to Him, “If Your Presence does not go *with us*, do not bring us up from here.

How desperate are we for the Presence of God?

August 11

Joshua 1:8 –“ this book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.”

Why is it important to meditate upon the word of God?

August 12

Judges 2:20 –“then the anger of the Lord was hot against Israel; and he said, because this nation has transgressed my covenant which I commanded their fathers, and his not heeded my voice, I also will no longer drive out before them any of the nations which Joshua left when he died.”

What are the consequences of a nation turns their back on God?

August 13

Ruth 1:16 –“ but Ruth said, entreat me not to leave you, or to turn back from following after you; for wherever you go, I will go; and wherever you lodge, I will lodge; your people shall be my people, and your God my God.”

How can you demonstrate your loyalty to the Lord?

August 14

Psalm 33:12 – “Blessed *is* the nation whose God *is* the Lord, The people He has chosen as His own inheritance.”

How might our nation return to the Lord and acknowledge His sovereignty and power?

August 15

1 Samuel 15:22 –“Then Samuel said, has the Lord as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the Lord?”

Why is obedience so important?

August 16

2 Samuel 22:21 –“ The Lord rewarded me according to my righteousness; according to the cleanness of my hands he has recompensed me.”

Can one person make a difference?

August 17

Matthew 6:33 – “But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all the things shall be added to you.”

Who are you seeking first in your life?

August 18

1 Kings 9:4,5 –“ now if you walk before me as your father David walked, in integrity heart and in uprightness, to do according to all that I have commanded you, and if you keep my statutes and my judgments, then I will establish the throne of your kingdom Israel forever, as I promised David your father, ‘saying you shall not fail to have a man on the throne of Israel.’”

What can we do to ensure righteous leadership?

August 19

2 Kings 17:22 –“ for the children of Israel walked in all the sins of Jeroboam which he did; they did not depart from them, until the Lord removed Israel out of his sight...”

Why are righteous leaders needed?

August 20

Psalm 51:17 – “The sacrifices of God *are* a broken spirit, A broken and a contrite heart—These, O God, You will not despise.”

How important is brokenness and contrition in our lives, our churches, our families, and our nation before the Lord?
