Mark 10:43-45 –“Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to be great among you shall be your servant. And whoever of you desires to be first shall be slave of all. For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life a ransom for many.”

In what capacity is Christ calling you to serve?

September 19

Luke 19:10 –“For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which is lost.”

Politics aside, what is a believer’s primary priority?

September 20

John 3:16 –“For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.”

In what ways has God demonstrated his love for the world?

September 21

Acts 1:8 –“But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”

Where does our power come from, and for what purpose is the power to be used?

September 22

Romans 1:16 –“For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to everyone that believes; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek (Gentile).”

The gospel of Christ is not something to be ashamed of because when shared, lived out and believed it has the power to change the USA!

September 23

1 Corinthians 13:13 –“And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love.”

Our only hope is to maintain faith that love wins! Pray boldly! Pray confidently! Pray compassionately!

September 24

Psalms 11:3 –“ If the foundations are destroyed, What can the righteous do?”

Pray that our nation and its leaders will build their lives and make decisions based upon the foundation of the Word of God.

September 25

Proverbs 3:5-6 –“ Trust in the Lord with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths.” Make these verses your mission in life to trust and acknowledge Him. Pray that our leaders will as well and they will not “lean” on their own understanding.

August 29

Isaiah 45:5 - "I am the Lord, and there is no other; There is no God besides Me. I will gird you, though you have not known Me."

As we pray, may we examine our lives to see that God is supreme in our life and that have not substituted anything or anyone in His place.

August 30

Ecclesiastes 12:13-14 – “Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God and keep His commandments, for this is the whole duty of man. For God will bring every work into judgment, including every secret thing, whether it is good or whether it is evil. Pray for leaders who will fear God and keep His commandments.

August 31

Song of Solomon 7:10 – “I am my beloved’s, and His desire is toward me.” Are you passionate about what God is passionate about?

September 1

Isaiah 9:6 – “For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given; and the government will be upon His shoulder.” God is in charge; He alone is our commander-in-chief.

September 2

Jeremiah 7:23-24 – “But this is what I commanded them, saying, ‘Obey My voice, and you shall be My people. And walk in all the ways that I have commanded you, that it may be well with you.’ Yet they did not obey or incline their ears, but walked in the counsels and in the imagination of their evil heart, and when back and not forward.”

What direction will the American people choose? Will we obey God, and walk in His ways? Or will we disobey God and walk in the counsel of our evil heart?

September 3

Ezekiel 37:3 – “And the Lord said to me, ‘Son of man, can these bones live?’ So I answered, ‘O Lord God, You know.’”

Can the dry spiritual bones scattered across the American landscape live again?

September 4

Daniel 2:44 – “And in the days of these kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which shall never be destroyed; and the kingdom shall not be left to other people; it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand forever.”

As believers we are part of an eternal kingdom that shall never be destroyed.

September 5

Hosea 4:1 – “Hear the word of the Lord, you children of Israel, for the Lord brings a charge against the inhabitants of the land: There is no truth or mercy or knowledge of God in the land.”

Pray that truth, mercy and the knowledge of God will be restored to America.

September 6

Joel 1:14 – “Consecrate a fast, call a sacred assembly; gather the elders and all the inhabitants of the land into the house of the Lord your God, and cry out to the Lord.”

Cry out to the Lord for revival in our land.

September 7

Amos 8:11 – “Behold, the days are coming,” says the Lord God, that I will send a famine on the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the Lord.”

Pray for a downpour of the word of the Lord on our land.

September 8

Obadiah 17 – “But on Mt. Zion there shall be deliverance, and there shall be holiness; the house of Jacob shall possess their possessions.”

Ask for deliverance and holiness to abound in America!

September 9

Jonah 4:11 – “And should I not pity Nineveh, that great city, in which are more than one hundred and twenty thousand persons who cannot discern between their right hand and their left...”

Pray for mercy upon our land.

September 10

Micah 6:8-“He has shown you, oh man, what is good; and what does the Lord require you but to do justly, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God.”

Practice justice, embrace mercy and walk humbly with your God today.

September 11

Nahum 2:1 – “He who scatters has come up before your face. Man the fort! Watch the road! Strengthen your flank! Fortify your power mightily!”

A spiritual battle requires “all hands on deck”, an alert army, a call for reinforcements and time to reload.

September 12

Habakkuk 1:5 – “Look among the nations and watch- be utterly astounded for I will v a work in your days which you would not believe though it were told you.”

Prepare your heart for a mighty move of God!

September 13

Zephaniah 2:1 –“Gather yourselves together, yes, gather together, O shameless nation

Seize opportunities to gather with God’s people to seek the Lord!

September 14

Haggai 2:7 –“and I will shake all nations, and they shall come to the Desire of all Nations, and I will fill this temple with glory,” says the Lord of hosts.

Run to the Desire of all Nations, Jesus!

September 15

Zechariah 2:13 –“Be silent, all flesh, before the Lord, for He is aroused from His holy habitation!”

Too much talk, and not enough fear of God. Be silent before the Lord today!

September 16

Malachi 4:1 –“For behold, the day is coming, Burning like an oven, And all the proud yes, all who do wickedly will be stubble. And the day which is coming shall burn the up,” Says the Lord of hosts, “That will leave them neither root nor branch.”

Pray for the proud to humble themselves and the wicked to repent. Include yourself in this prayer!

September 17

Matthew 16:16 – “And Simon Peter answered and said, ‘You are the Christ, the son of the living God.’”
