### LIVING WATER Sunday AM

God created you with a spiritual thirst that only He can satisfy. God's people have always been prone to seasons of spiritual dryness. Before God will quench your thirsty soul, you must be convinced of how dry it really is. Allowing God to inspect the true condition of your heart is the first step toward quenching your spiritual thirst.

### WHAT DOES GOD'S WORD SAY?

- Oh God, you are my God; earnestly I seek you; my soul thirsts for you; my flesh faints for you, as in a dry and weary land where there is no water (Psalm 63:1).
- "Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied" (Matthew 5:6).
- "Repent therefore, and turn back, that your sins may be blotted out, that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord" (Acts 3:19).

### THE EMPTINESS OF SUBSTITUTES Sunday PM

God commands you to forsake your idols and worship Him alone. A misdirected thirst will find many artificial substitutes, which will never satisfy. You must identify and turn from the substitutes before Jesus will quench your thirst at the fountain of living water.

### WHAT DOES GOD'S WORD SAY?

- "You shall have no other gods before me. You shall not make for yourself a carved image [an idol].... You shall not bow down to them or serve them, for I the LORD your God am a jealous God" (Exodus 20:3-5).
- Little children, keep yourselves from idols (1 John 5:21).
- Put to death therefore what is earthly in you: sexual immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry (Colossians 3:5).
- Many, of whom I have often told you and now tell you even with tears, walk as enemies of the cross of Christ. Their end is destruction, their god is their belly, and they glory in their shame, with minds set on earthly things (Philippians 3:18-19).
- "Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me, and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me" (Matthew 10:37).

### TEST: Am I worshiping idols?

- What am I most afraid of losing?
- What do I long for or desire most passionately?
- Where do I run for comfort, joy, or satisfaction?
- What or who makes me feel the most secure?
- What do I brag about?
- What do I sacrifice the most for?

### YOUR LIFE IN ACTION

"Lord, I choose to identify and turn from my idols so that I might worship You in spirit and truth."

### THE AFTERTASTE OF SIN Monday PM

God calls you to demonstrate your love for Him by choosing obedience. There is an initial sweetness to sin, but it leaves a bitter aftertaste. Until sin is confessed and forsaken, we will never experience the blessing Jesus promised to those who hunger and thirst for righteousness.

### WHAT DOES GOD'S WORD SAY?

- "If you love me, you will keep my commandments" (John 14:15).
- This is the love of God, that we keep his commandments. And his commandments are not burdensome (1 John 5:3).
- "Blessed . . . are those who hear the word of God and keep it!" (Luke 11:28).
- Whoever knows the right thing to do and fails to do it, for him it is sin (James 4:17).
- If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9).

"Partial obedience, delayed obedience, and surface obedience to impress others are not acceptable to God. He is looking for men and women who will respond with instant, complete, wholehearted, and joyous obedience each time He speaks." (Del Fehsenfeld Jr.)

TEST: Am I currently living a life of obedience to God?

- Am I continuing to do something that I know God wants me to stop?
- Is there anything I know God wants me to do that I have not yet done?
- Have I placed any limits on what I am willing to do for God?
- Is it difficult for me to confess my sins to God?
- Am I aware of specific sins I have not confessed and forsaken?

### YOUR LIFE IN ACTION

"Lord, help me demonstrate my love for You by choosing to confess and repent of my sin so that I might obey You more."

### **REFRESHING RELATIONSHIPS** Tuesday PM

Though God intends you to enjoy healthy relationships with others, hurt is inevitable in a broken world. When hurt spills out on families, churches, and other relationships, it can create a mess. The residue of hurt will never be cleaned up without the power of forgiveness.

### WHAT DOES GOD'S WORD SAY?

- "This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends" (John 15:12-13).
- Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love... We love because he first loved us (1 John 4:7-8, 19).
- If there is any encouragement in Christ, any comfort from love, any participation in the Spirit, any affection and sympathy, complete my joy by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind (Philippians 2:1-2).
- Bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive (Colossians 3:13).

"We should not . . . think of our fellowship with other Christians as a spiritual luxury, an optional addition to the exercises of private devotion. We should recognize rather that such fellowship is a spiritual necessity; for God has made us in such a way that our fellowship with himself is fed by our fellowship with fellow Christians, and requires to be so fed constantly for its own deepening and enrichment." (J. I. Packer)

### THE LOVE TEST: Am I demonstrating the love of Christ through my words and actions?

Love is patient and kind; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth (1 Corinthians 13:4-6).

### THE RESERVOIR OF GOD'S SPIRIT Wednesday PM

God has given you His Holy Spirit to empower you for successful Christian living. Christians are commanded to be filled with God's Spirit, but the truth is, as broken cisterns . . . we leak. God quenches every thirst when we drink deeply from the reservoir of His Spirit.

### WHAT DOES GOD'S WORD SAY?

- "I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him" (John 14:16-17).
- Do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is. And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery, but be filled with the Spirit (Ephesians 5:17-18).
- Walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do (Galatians 5:16-17).
- All who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God (Romans 8:14).

### TEST: Am I currently depending on the Holy Spirit?

- Am I exhausting all my resources before looking to the Holy Spirit for help in a specific situation?
- Am I trusting the Holy Spirit to give me power to overcome sinful attitudes and actions?
- Am I grieving the Holy Spirit by not confessing and forsaking known sins?
- Am I quenching the Holy Spirit by neglecting prayer and time in the Word?
- Am I allowing the Holy Spirit to lead me?




