Graduate Sunday April 26

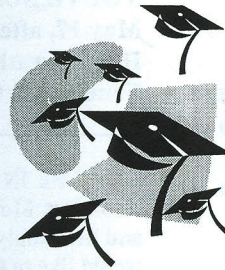
The Graduate Service will take place during the 10:30 a.m. service this coming Sunday.
