YOUTH ENSEMBLE AUDITIONS HAVE BEGUN! You may audition during the times below or by "appointment". To cut down on "wait" time, this year we will be emphasizing certain weeks for certain grades.

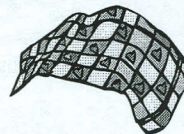
There is one more place we'll visit on the way home, but it's a surprise. (Sorry, no clues.)
